

THE LEGENDS AT GROVE CITY RULES AND REGULATIONS GOVERNING THE SWIMMING POOL

The pool at The Legends at Grove City is available for the relaxation and enjoyment of the residents for the community and their guests. However, for liability and safety reasons, the following rules for its usage adopted by the Board of Directors shall apply.

The Legends at Grove City provides no lifeguard supervision. All persons using the pool do so at their own risk. All accidents must be reported to the Community Manager.

IN CASE OF EMERGENCY, CALL 911, POLICE OR AMBULANCE.

1. The pool will be open daily 8:00 am to 8:00 p.m. Memorial Day weekend through Labor Day. Pool hours are subject to change without notice.
2. The pool is for residents. All guests must be accompanied by a resident over the age of 18 years old.
3. Children 14 years old and under must be accompanied by a parent or guardian. Unsupervised children will be asked to leave the pool area.
4. Children 6 years and under must wear a life-saving device while in the pool.
5. Anyone creating a disturbance will be asked to leave the pool area.
6. No glass is permitted in the pool area.
7. No alcoholic beverages are permitted in the immediate pool area.
8. Animals (dogs or cats) are prohibited in the pool area.
9. No wet bathers are permitted in the clubhouse.
10. Residents are responsible for their guests' safety and behavior and should be monitored at all times.
11. Pool patrons who become disorderly, cause damage, or disobey rules will be denied future use of the pool.
12. Residents are to read and follow all rules. The accompanying adult/guardian is responsible for their accompanying children's compliance.

13. The swimming pool may be closed at the discretion of the Board of Directors or Management due to inclement weather, failure of equipment and/or other conditions, which may jeopardize the health, and safety of any user. The pool will close and all swimmers will leave the pool area at the first sign of an electrical storm. Pool will reopen after the storm has cleared.
14. Unauthorized use of the pool will be deemed a trespass of private property and will be reported to the local police department for prosecution.
15. Disposable diapers are prohibited in pool. Children not toilet trained are required to wear leak proof pants in the pool.
16. In case of problems other than emergency – i.e. failure of equipment or other conditions, which may jeopardize the health or safety of any user, contact the Management office.
17. DIVING AND RUNNING ARE PROHIBITED.
